#### **Senator Dianne Feinstein:**

"I oppose it as a matter of equality and fairness. The right to marry is fundamental. It provides social stability, economic equality and the ability to make decisions for a spouse in a time of crisis. If Proposition 8 were to pass, not only would it eliminate the right to marry for gay and lesbian couples, but it would also create a complicated legal quagmire for those who have exercised this right under the California Constitution. The views of Californians on this issue have changed over time, and as a state, I believe we should uphold the ability of our friends, neighbors and co-workers who are gay and lesbian to enter into the contract of marriage. I urge Californians to oppose Proposition 8."

#### **California Teachers Association:**

"CTA believes that all people should be allowed equal protections under the law. California's constitution should guarantee the same freedoms and rights to everyone – no one group should be singled out and have their rights taken away. Proposition 8 mandates one set of rules for gay and lesbian couples and another set of rules for everyone else. That's not fair. California laws should treat everyone equally."
